WHAT IS CCP

CCP is the Community Care Program which provides funding for housing in New Jersey through DDD. DDD oversees and approves services for children and adults in New Jersey.

Step 1.

The biggest step to transitioning your child will be to apply for services through the Division of Developmental Disabilities:

- **Where:** <https://www.nj.gov/humanservices/ddd/individuals/applyservices/>
- **Why** This will provide eligibility if approved for a number on the **wait list** for housing.
- **How** Use the above link to apply. A representative will reach out to you.



Step 2.

Choose a support coordinator:

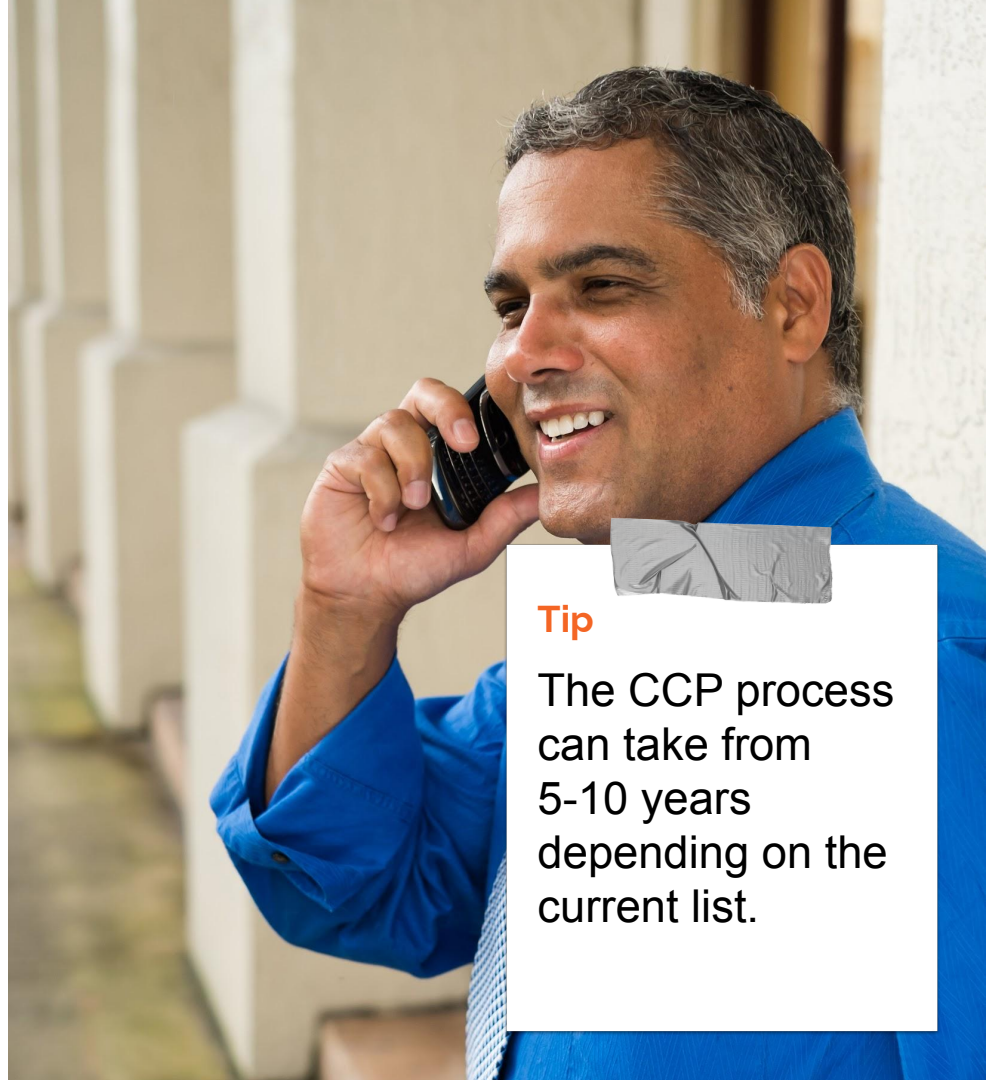
Once you are approved for the wait list, you will work on obtaining a support coordinator. Use the link below to select a coordinator and begin this process

Step 3.

You will also need to complete a New Jersey Comprehensive Assessment Tool by reviewing the below link and registering to complete the process. The result will provide you with your child's tier which is equivalent to a budget. The tier will be used by your support coordinator to complete their Individual Service Plan (ISP) and Service Detail Report (SDR) which is the authorization for services.

The CCP process can take from 5-10 years depending on the current list.
