

What grade level will your child be entering in September 2020?

f we implement an A/B model in September, please indicate which model you would prefer:




- 1. Alternating A/B Model: One week your child attends school in the building on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday and the following week your child attends school in the building on Tuesday and Thursday. This pattern would repeat. This model is preferred by building principals since your child will receive in-person instruction every other day.
- 2. A/B model with Consistent Days: One week your child attends school in the building Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday and the following week Monday and Thursday. This pattern would repeat. This model creates a more consistent schedule for child care. While it does not have the every other day direct instruction preferred by your child's principal, your child would receive the same amount of in-person instruction during the academic year.
- 3. A/B Model with Virtual Wednesdays for All: Your child attends school in the building Monday and Thursday (or Tuesday and Friday) every week. Wednesday is a virtual learning day for the entire district every week. This model is not supported by the principals and administration since it has 18 less in-person instruction days for each student. Parents would also have to pay for child care for an additional 18 days.

If we implement a four hour day in September, lunch will not be included into the schedule. Would you be interested in purchasing a "grab and go lunch". Your child would order a boxed lunch from a limited menu in the morning and would receive it before leaving at the end of the day to bring home with them. Please note, lunch will still be provided at home for our Free and Reduced Lunch Students.
