Administrative Procedures for the Reinforcement of Bus Safety Regulations

First Occurrence:

Driver cautions and counsels student, and takes corrective measures.

Second Occurrence:

- A. Driver completes bus conduct report and submits it to the building administrator.
 - Building administrator conferences with student.

Third Occurrence:

- Building administrator contacts parent. A. Bus conduct report is completed.

 B. Building administrator contacts

Fourth Occurrence:

- A. Bus conduct report is completed.
- Student is suspended from bus or is assigned detention. The number if days is determined by the severity of the misconduct.

Fifth Occurrence:

- Bus conduct report is completed.
- Minimum suspension is one week.
- Parents attend conference with administrator.

Further Occurrence:

Bus suspension from two weeks up to the remainder of the school year, to be determined by the administration.

The severity of the misconduct may cause an administrator to accelerate the above process or take other necessary action.




