- <u>Trimester Dates:</u> Please be aware that Trimester 1 officially ends today, on December 9, however you will notice that grades may change as submitted work and assessments are entered by the teachers. The grades will be considered final and the report card for Trimester 1 will be released on December 20.
- <u>Assemblies:</u> Students have now attended two different assemblies hosted by the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office to reinforce our expectations on internet safety, cyberbullying and respectful behavior. - Technology Use: As we continue to support your children in their educational journey, I want to take a moment to address an important matter regarding the appropriate use of technology at school. Recently, we have observed instances where some students have used technology, including district-issued devices and personal phones, to take pictures and videos during class or post school events online. While we value the role technology plays in enhancing learning, it is crucial that all students adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy and the guidelines outlined in the Student Handbook.

To maintain a focused and safe learning environment, please review the following expectations with your child:

## • District-Issued Technology:

All district-issued devices are provided to support academic work. These devices must only be used for school-related purposes and in accordance with the Acceptable Use Policy.

## Personal Devices

As stated in the Student Handbook, personal phones and devices must remain **off and away** during the school day. This includes class time, lunch, and transitions. Unauthorized use of personal devices can be distracting and detract from the positive learning environment we strive to maintain.

## • Respecting Privacy:

Students should refrain from taking pictures or videos of peers, teachers, or classroom activities without explicit permission. Sharing such content online without consent can lead to privacy concerns and unintended consequences.

We kindly ask for your support in reinforcing these expectations at home. By working together, we can help students develop responsible digital habits and ensure that our school remains a respectful and productive environment for everyone. Thank you for your attention to this matter and for your continued partnership in your child's education. Should you have any questions or need further clarification, please feel free to reach out.

• <u>Dress Code Reminder:</u> Slippers, flip flops or any other footwear with very soft soles and/or no backs cannot be worn in school. If wearing Crocs, please be sure the back strap is in place.
