To Our Pine Brook Community,

Pirates, congratulations on a great first month of school! We have accomplished so much in our first twenty days together, including Starts with Hello Week, the start of year benchmark assessments, a PBSIS assembly, and Back to School Night. We are now looking forward to all that October will bring!

Please review the following important October information:

- <u>Quinmester/Trimester 1 Midpoint</u>: The week of October 7 marks the halfway mark of your child's participation in their first cycle at Pine Brook School! The first cycle ends on November 14, and the second cycle begins on November 15. Additionally, October 21 marks the middle of the first trimester for all core content areas, which would be a great time to review with your child their current progress as indicated on the Genesis Parent Portal. Please click into each grade listed next to the subject area for an account of all graded assignments during the trimester thus far. We encourage you to reach out to your child's teachers if you have any questions or concerns.
- <u>Chromebook Care-</u> Please support your children in ensuring their chromebooks are charged each evening and brought to school each morning in their school issued case. As a reminder, your child will use this chromebook through the end of their 8th grade year, and so it is essential to engage in proper care techniques.
- <u>Internet Safety</u> As part of our ongoing commitment to the safety and well-being of our students, on October 1 we hosted an Internet Safety Assembly in collaboration with the Monmouth County Sheriff's Department. During the assembly, students were provided with valuable tips and resources to help them navigate the online world safely and responsibly. We encourage you to take some time to discuss these important tips with your children at home and reinforce the key safety practices outlined during the assembly. Some of the key points covered include:
 - Think Before You Post: Remind your child to always be mindful of what they share online. Once something is posted, it can be difficult to take back.
 - Keep Personal Information Private: Students were advised to never share personal information such as their full name, address, or school online.
 - Use Strong Passwords: Creating unique and strong passwords helps protect personal accounts from unauthorized access.
 - **Be Aware of Cyberbullying:** Encourage your child to report any instances of online bullying to a trusted adult.
 - Safe Interactions Online: Remind students to avoid talking to strangers or sharing personal details with people they don't know.
